Summary of the proposed programme: (Briefly state the programme)	 1995-2006 Every year since 1995, Osaka University of Economics and Law (Japan) and Soongsil University (Korea) have co-organized a series of International educational seminars. 2007-2008 Fudan University has joined the seminar since 2007 and it became a multilateral Seminar. 2009 Far Eastern National University joined the seminar on 2009. The four universities has discussed the feasibility of the further development of the seminar by inviting a new participants from National Taiwan University. The main focuses of the seminar are placed on cultivating the academic interests and building friendship among students from different, but neighbouring countries. The participants travel Vladivostok and Shanghai together for ten days and attend the special lecture and discussion. PROGRAMME DETAIL

Programme Theme:

"-Regionalism and Globalization in East Asia-"

Objectives of the programme:

The seminar, one of international educational programmes of OUEL, is designed for the university students, thus contributes to creating the friendly-ties at grass-roots level.

Osaka University of Economics and Law (OUEL) has been planning a way of cooperation with its oversea sister-universities with a view to providing them with the opportunity of sharing knowledge and images of the others, especially with those in neighbouring countries.

In order to achieve the goal, the universities share the recognition that it is meaningful for the young generation to learn a way to settle a difference in an amicable manner through an academic and educational programme.

The seminar in 2016 covers a wide range of interrelated sub-topics and activities.

The objectives of the seminar (Programme) are:

- ① To stimulate the intellectual curiosity and to share the academic thought among participants.
- 2 Promotion of mutual understanding among participants and to cultivate the international mind.
- ③ To encourage gaining perspectives to achieve the peace and the prosperity in the Taiwan region.

Delivery of the programme:

- (o) Selection: in June 2016
- (1) Preparation: from June to August
 The selected students will gather related-materials, brush up communication skills, and prepare
 presentation, discussion and cultural events.
- (2) Keynote Lectures (Each lecture is to be followed by Q&A and discussion) By Invited speakers from OUEL, Fudan, Soongsil
- (3) Students' Presentation and Discussion (prepare PPT according to the theme)
- (4) Fieldwork / Field Trip: (Each activity is to be followed by discussion)
- (5) Cultural Exchange Events
 - Language Exchange Class
 - 2 Cultural Exchange Event by the participants
 - ③ Cultural Experience

Expected results of the programme:

- 1. Promotion of mutual understanding
- (1) The seminar will be an invaluable opportunity for the participants to build up the future-oriented relations and to learn international mind through the related lectures and activities.
- (2) The seminar will provide not only participants but also citizens outside the university with an opportunity to exchange with "neighbours" through the programme and other cultural events.
- 2. Educational Effect

It is expected, as an effect of the seminar, that many of the participants will fully realize the need for international mind and fluent communication skills with foreign friends. This effect has been proved by the experiences in the past decade.

- 3. Number of people it is expected will be affected by the programme.:
 - (1) Direct : 40 (participants)
 - (2) Indirect: approximately 100 (the universities' staff and citizens)
